The Technology Leadership Forums are truly collaborative, with participants engaged in active learning experiences modeled throughout the quarterly leadership forums and five online Adobe Connect webinars. The forums will also provide K-12 school district teams essential and critical information updates from Wisconsin DPI and national IT information hubs.

Districts may send an edtech leadership team to each face-to-face forum. Teams may consist of administrators, technology coordinators/directors, LMC specialists, and lead educators.
